I am pleased to submit the AGM report for the year ending June 2019.

The Association has been able to partner with other ministries and missions overseas and within Australia over the year seeing many benefit from the programs, training and support given.

As part of the end of last year in September and October of 2018 we were invited to minister in France engaging with the Connexion Eglise healing centre, within their men's and women's ministry programs as well as the youth group. A variety of training and seminars were provided to these groups - topics around leadership, finances, mental health and wellbeing. The people were encouraged immensely, and we have had wonderful feedback from the lead Pastors of the ministry that was received. As we were invited to return this September/October 2019 and once again provide training for the men, women and a healing seminar plus a young adult's event on the weekend. Many were in attendance and received ministry and help through the programs presented. Over 40 people in attendance to the healing seminar.

Over this 12 month period I had the privilege of ministering in Melbourne and Sydney at two women's conferences including the Sunday churches services where over 200 women were in attendance at the conferences including a women's retreat in Sydney.

Throughout the year we have been able to support other ministries and the Wellspring Healing Centre weekly program in Wodonga.

These ministries both in Australia and overseas, have benefited through receiving financial gifts and donations to help with their ongoing training programs, support to their rent of the building in France, support to Eternal life ministries in Philippines for buildings that were destroyed in the cyclone in Tacloban and nearby villages. The distribution of donations was given to those who had the most needs where the cyclone had damaged their homes roofs and parts of their church building.

We have also sponsored many of the church's pastors with food, including rice bags, funds to help within their community outreaches, one being for their music program, a new drum kit and equipment for their church music program.

The year at the Wellspring Healing centre has been extremely significant in seeing many women come through the weekly program receiving; support, care and training regarding mental health and wellbeing. The Association was able to support the ongoing program as well as a women's retreat for 25 women in July 2019. The testimonies of transformation and healing were a wonderful encouragement and we are proposing another retreat in 2020 as a result. Wellspring Healing centre

has provided a space for women to feel nurtured and safe as well as equipped with life skills and mental health and wellbeing.

Another ministry we have been able to sponsor has been Mothers Heart in Cambodia. Helping young women with pregnancy and single parenting, providing care for both baby and mother. Paula Connelly Association was able to send donations to help with clothing and supplies for the mothers and their newborn babies.

We also sponsor monthly through compassion a child in the Philippines. We receive feedback and reports regularly of the child's progress.
